

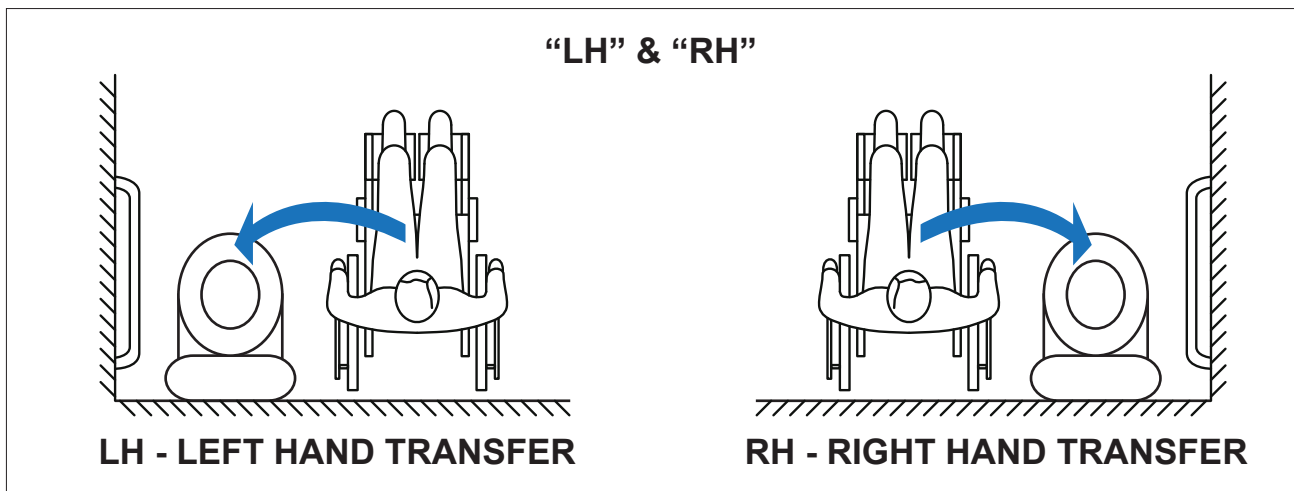

## HOW TO: WHAT IS LH & RH



### What is LH & RH

LH stands for LEFT HAND TRANSFER.  
RH stands for RIGHT HAND TRANSFER.

LH or RH is only required for accessible toilet signs.

### How to determine if you require LH or RH

Simply put, it is the direction of movement from the wheelchair to the pan.

As shown in the diagram, LH toilets should have a space for the wheelchair on the right side of the pan, requiring the user to move to the LEFT to access the pan, hence LH. While RH toilets should have a space for the wheelchair on the left of the pan, requiring the user to move to the RIGHT to access the pan, hence RH.
